History & CELEBRATE THE PAST SHERILLAGE

AMERICA IS CELEBRATING ITS 250TH BIRTHDAY IN 2026!

merica's semiquincentennial is in 2026, and Miami County will be joining many other communities throughout the state to celebrate the events, people and places that impacted Ohio during the American Revolutionary War and beyond. Miami County has a rich history dating back centuries. Here are just a few of the places that continue to honor those that came before us and had an impact on the growth of Miami County and beyond.

OVERFIELD TAVERN MUSEUM

1808 was a time when the small settlement of Troy, Ohio was on the great

frontier. This tavern was a gathering place for social and government purposes and is now open to the public as a museum featuring a collection of late-18th to early-19th century artifacts. The two-story Federal style square-hewn log building has survived as the oldest building in Miami County and one of the oldest in Ohio and is on the National Register of Historic Places.

MIAMI VALLEY VETERANS MUSEUM

Serving a seven-county area, the fiveacre Miami Valley Veterans Museum is a long-term repository for artifacts, photos, over 250 veterans' interviews in their Research/Multimedia Center and other objects of significance to veterans and their families. Museum exhibits reflect time periods from 1745 to the present day and focus on all branches of the military.

JOHNSTON FARM & INDIAN AGENCY

Johnston Farm & Indian Agency celebrates 2000 years of Ohio's rich history from prehistoric Indians to Ohio's canal era while honoring John Johnston – farmer, public official, and U.S. Indian Agent for western Ohio from 1812 to 1829. On a visit to Johnston Farm, guests will enjoy a ride on The



General Harrison, a replica 70-foot-long canal boat, drawn by mules, which at one time was used to haul passengers and cargo along the Miami and Erie Canal. Costumed guides on the boat and farm provide an authentic and memorable experience back in time.

WACO LEARNING CENTER & AIR MUSEUM

The Weaver Aircraft Company (WACO) was the largest manufacturer of civil aircraft in the US in the late 1920's and early 1930's. Today, at this historic field and museum, you can take a flight in WACO's biplane, "Sunny", to see beautiful Miami County from the sky. In addition, WACO offers a wide range of learning opportunities. With a mission to educate and inspire students and adults who have a passion for flying, WACO has developed programs around science, technology, engineering and math as it relates to aviation.

Miami County is proud of its history and heritage and the people who have impacted its forward progress. These are just a few of the places to visit and learn. Over the next couple of years, Miami County, and its communities, organizations and businesses will be celebrating America 250 through telling the stories of the people and places who made a difference in Ohio and the nation. Eldean Bridge 🔺

Built in 1860, Eldean Bridge is the longest "Long Truss" covered bridge in the country spanning 224 feet. Its historical significance earned it a spot on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975, and in 2016, it was further honored as a National Historic Landmark.

ort Pigua Plaza 🔺

Built in 1891, the Fort Piqua Plaza has been an icon of history in Piqua for over 130 years. This hotel played host to many prominent people including Teddy Roosevelt and William Howard Taft who both spoke from its balcony during their campaign tours in 1912. This beautiful Late-Victorian style building is now home to the Piqua Public Library and a grand banquet center.

Halderman Barn Museum >

A visit to the Halderman Barn Museum is a trip through 60 years of Mustang history. You will be awed as you peruse wall-to-wall, floor-to-ceiling exhibits including automobiles, historical photos, original drawings, posters, awards, and an extensive collection of other memorabilia dedicated to this iconic car.

Indian Creek Distillery -

A "true sip of history", Indian Creek Distillery whiskeys are uniquely small batch where art, science and heritage combine to produce a spirit like no other. Using the oldest copper pot stills in the country, their award-winning Legendary Ohio Frontier Whiskeys are created with a passionate dedication to authenticity – slowly and thoughtfully crafted.

Built in 1914, the former home of Mary Jane Hayner now serves as the arts and culture hub of Miami County. ◆ Bradford Ohio Railroad Museum

BRADFORD OHIO RAILROAD MUSEUM / BRADFORD JUNCTION INTERLOCKING TOWER

200 North Miami Avenue, Bradford 937-552-2196. BradfordRRMuseum.org

This museum is dedicated to the preservation of Bradford's railroad heritage. The museum has also restored Bradford's Pennsylvania Railroad BF interlocking tower which is located at 501 East Main Street.

COVINGTON-NEWBERRY HISTORICAL **SOCIETY MUSEUM**

101 East Spring Street, Covington 937-216-2477, CovingtonHistory.org

Located in an 1849 schoolhouse, the museum features displays relating to the history of Covington and Newberry Township.

CIVIL WAR MONUMENT

Intersection of State Routes 48 and 718. Pleasant Hill Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to "her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves," it serves as a memorial to those who go to war, and never return

ELDEAN COVERED BRIDGE

A National Historic Landmark Corner of N. County Road 25-A & Eldean Road, Troy Built in 1860, it's one of only two covered

bridges remaining in the county and is the longest "Long Truss" covered bridge in the nation.

ELIZABETH TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL MUSEUM

5760 East Walnut Grove Road, Troy 937-339-5209, EthsOfOhio.com

The museum features a school room with artifacts and photos from the one room schools to Miami East today.

FLETCHER COVERED BRIDGE

Downing Street (one block north of U.S. 36), Fletcher Dedicated in 1998, the covered bridge is a new look at an old style of bridge design.

FORT PIQUA PLAZA

116 West High Street, Downtown Pigua 937-773-6753 (Piqua Library)

Built in 1891, the Fort Pigua Plaza is a revitalized historic building that serves as the heart of Piqua featuring the Piqua Public Library, banquet center, restaurants and shops.

in 2020 at the age of 87, but his story lives on through his personal collection of items from his life and career at the Ford Motor Company. Tours by appointment only.

INDIAN CREEK DISTILLERY

This early American artisan farm distillery features the oldest working stills in America and offers on-site whiskey sales, tastings, and tours.

Completed in 1888, the courthouse stands as one of the tallest structures in the county. towering 185 feet above the Great Miami River and is fitted with a copper statue of justice with bronze statues in attendance.



PICTURE PERFECT MURALS IN MIAMI COUNTY

iami County is home to multiple marvelous murals. From the picture perfect selfie walls to honoring the history of the area, Miami County

murals that make for a perfect backdrop to any photo. The mural located at **Prouty** Plaza, designed by artist Aka Pereyma, uses different colors and shapes that makes for a fun and funky background. The mural in the parking lot of the **Troy Rec** portrays a black and white image of a canal boat with downtown scenery. The newest downtown Troy mural is located in the southwest quadrant of the Square and highlights many aspects

everything in between.

On the corner of East High and North has a variety of murals for you to explore. Main in downtown Piqua, you'll find a tall mural showcasing the Miami and Downtown Troy has some fabulous Erie Canal as well as early settlers of Pigua. Stand on Veterans Memorial Way to get the right angle to include the entire mural in your photo. Walk a block and see the county's newest mural of the Mills Brothers. An image of the Pigua native musicians is on the side of the Park National Bank building, on the corner of Main Street and Water Street.

> Grab an ice cream and take a cute photo sitting on the bench in front of

of Troy, from industry to recreation and the Gem City Ice Cream mural. Located on the corner of North Second and East Main in downtown Tipp City, this mural is a classic photo spot. Or walk a block down the Alleyway connecting Coldwater Café and the Tipp City Public Library to see the town's newest mural. Immerse yourself in the art as you stand for the "I" in Tipp. This mural was completed in fall of 2020 by Tipp City native Atalie Gagnet.

> For those who are photo savvy and love to find new and unique spots to take the perfect pictures, Miami County has plenty of murals to choose from. Be sure to check out these backdrops for your next photo inspiration.



HONORING PIQUA'S MUSICAL PIONEERS

The Mills Brothers were pioneers of the African American music scene. The vocal jazz quartet was born and raised in Piqua, Ohio until they moved to New York City in the 1930s to start their music career. The Mills Brothers became the first African American singers to have their own radio show, "Four Boys and a Guitar". The group sold over 50 million copies of more than 2,000 recordings.

This mural project was started by Mainstreet Pigua, and artwork and painting was done by a Columbus artist. It was funded through donations from many organizations and personal donors, and now is proudly displayed in downtown Piqua. After many years of planning and fundraising, the mural came to life in late summer of 2024. This art work is a great way to honor the legacy of these Piqua native, musical legends. You can find the mural in downtown Pigua on the side of the Park National Bank building, on the corner of Main Street and Water Street, across from Crooked Handle Brewing Co.

REST ON THE RIVER

Sleep in a floating tent? For real? When I heard about this one-of-a-kind unique camping experience, I immediately said, "Sign me up!" Now just because I said, "sign me up," does not mean that I was not thinking this whole camping on the Great Miami River thing through. I mean, what does something like this entail?

A Shoal Tent is the first of its kind inflatable, floating raft with a tent topper that allows you to sleep out on the water. There are no tent poles or set-up style forms, and the tent is entirely inflatable. The material in the tent is a six-inch-high pressure flooring that is similar to a paddleboard, which now doubles as your floating bed.

You get to your tent in these amazing Smithfly rafts that are surprisingly stable. Carefully load up your gear to paddle out for your stay. As you dip your oar into the water and bring it back up, a few drops of water will come along with it. Each stroke takes you closer to the tents, which are numbered. Maneuver your raft to the door of your booked tent. and vou're there. Pro-Tip: Pack light! I am not kidding.

Honestly, this was pretty spectacular! Sitting at the door of the tent with the flaps open, I could enjoy the cool dusk breezes, feel the water rushing beneath the tent, and listen to the sounds of the evening beginning to fall.

make your stay more entertaining and enjoyable. We brought a deck of cards to play a game before it got dark. I am

> Pro-Tip: I had a lot of people ask me about the bathroom. Well, it is a tent. so there is no bathroom. You have two options, paddle to the shore and use the bathroom located there or bring a port-a-potty.

Laceup your hiking boots, grab your rain gear and check out these local water wonders.

Located within the Greenville Falls State Scenic River Area. Greenville Falls is a beautiful cascading waterfall surrounded by hiking trails, a natural arch, and plenty of history. Visitors can watch the cascades slide about 20 feet over natural rock formations into Greenville Creek and through a natural limestone arch formed by the flowing waters. The 92-acre park also includes a system of trails that allow visitors to stroll along the river and admire the natural beauty.

Charleston Falls Preserve is one of the most visited nature parks in Miami County. Home to more than 216 acres of forests and prairie lands with four miles of trails, the crown jewel of this preserve is the waterfall. Sharing the same rock strata as its namesake, Niagara Falls, the "Miniature Niagara" scales about 37 feet tall and continues into the Great Miami River. The approximate four miles of trails meander through a variety of natural habitats to explore, perfect for all skill levels.

Ludlow Falls is considered one of the bestkept secrets of Miami County. Located in the village of Ludlow Falls, Ohio, this impressive waterfall is tucked underneath a bridge heading into town. This impressive waterfall has a 15-foot drop and is about 50-60 feet deep. Springtime is considered the best time to visit the falls when the cascades are the most powerful and beautiful. These beautiful falls are made for viewing only. Accessing the Falls is as easy to reach as it is to miss, you just have to take a short trail.

If you enjoy the outdoors and exploring beautiful natural creations, vou'll appreciate the opportunities that the waterfalls in Miami County provide.
